



# **Diesel Mechanic**

## **Main Functions:**

Working with The Blue Heron Company, our full time Mechanic will maintain all of the vessels in the fleet, as well as vehicles within the company.

## **Reports to:**

Owners - Rick and Jack Salen, Captains, and General Manager - Ashley Miller

## **Job Duties:**

Diesel Mechanic performs some or all of the following duties:

- Do routine maintenance by following a check list for the inspection process
- Perform tasks such as replacing oil or lubricating equipment during routine maintenance.
- Daily checks on all vessels
- Oil Changes for all vessels and vehicles
- Recondition and replace parts such as pistons, bearings, gears, valves, etc.
- Replace and repair damaged and malfunctioning parts, machinery, etc.

## **Skills Requirements:**

- Experience is a requirement.

## **Essential Skill Requirements:**

- Attention to detail
- Dexterity
- Self-Motivated
- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Mechanical and Technical 'Know How'
- Ability to work independently
- Punctual, meticulous and reliable

## **Working Conditions:**

- Workweeks are 5 or 6 days, Monday – Sunday, 6-12 hours per day, no shifts beginning before 6:00 am or finishing later than 7:00pm.
- Mechanics are entitled to a ½ hour paid lunch and two 15 minute coffee breaks paid time – but the time this is taken must be flexible.
- Mechanics are frequently exposed to noise and time limitations.
- Mechanics will be assigned changing priorities.
- Mechanics must be available when issues arise and have a flexible work week. On call help is sometimes required and appreciated.
- Mechanics may have the opportunity to work overtime, with paid compensation.
